

FRAM tools and applications

The range of FRAM applications continues to grow, both in terms of the industry domains and of the scope and objectives under which is used. A significant contribution to this trend was the launching of the “FRAM visualiser”. Since its first version, this tool has become widely used and is likely to be the main support of every FRAM-based analysis within recent years.

A new version of the FRAM visualiser was recently released and brought important new features that open up new possibilities for FRAM applications and FRAM-based analysis approaches. Also recently, the “myFRAM” application was made available and has demonstrated a great potential to facilitate a wide range of qualitative and quantitative analysis that can be derived from a FRAM model.

This workshop will offer guidance on the use of these FRAM-based tools and will explore their potential based on practical cases.
