§ 1 **NorSIS in the world**

Since its initiation in 1996, the Nordic Society for Intermedial Studies has become an increasingly international association. Are there any other international scholarly associations devoted to intermediality? Is it time for NorSIS to become an international association also by name? Should the conferences be held also outside the Nordic countries?

The initiative to make NorSIS into an international association was very well received.

The board was asked to hold a board meeting in order to discuss how such a change should be effected: The board should have international members (who, how/when should the election take place?); what should the name be? (just eliminate Nordic?); change of statutes, et cetera.

The assembly asks the chairman to arrange a board meeting on the topic not before too long.

§ 2 **Next NorSIS conference**

Suggestions for venue and date for the next conference.

As a result of the previous discussion it was suggested that the next conference should be held outside the Nordic countries.

Since Netherlands had the largest delegation at the conference it was suggested that these delegates discussed the possibility among themselves to arrange the 2013 conference in Netherlands.
