§ 1 **Forthcoming ISIS conferences**

Rong Ou, Hangzhou Normal University, China, has already offered herself to organize a future ISIS conference. The suggestion was well received by the last general assembly two years ago in Utrecht. Two possible time frames for this conference were now discussed: October 2018 or May 2019. Potential themes were also conferred. The assembly furthermore received two proposals for conference venues after the event in China: Christophe Collard suggested Vrije Universiteit, Brussels, and Martin Laliberté suggested Université Paris-Est Marne La Vallée. Both proposals were seconded by the participants of the general assembly.

§ 2 **ISIS journal**

No news regarding previous efforts to launch a new intermedial journal were reported. As an alternative, a digital publishing tool named Scala was mentioned. This is a platform that can share information, translations, presentations of work, and other forms of media content.

§ 3 **Other business**

It was suggested that the association's website could be developed. This requires either voluntary work from a webmaster or a financial basis. Membership fees would be one way of raising money for a more advanced website. Several participants in the assembly furthermore pointed out that the society's acronym ISIS is problematic due to its associations to the terrorist organization.
